

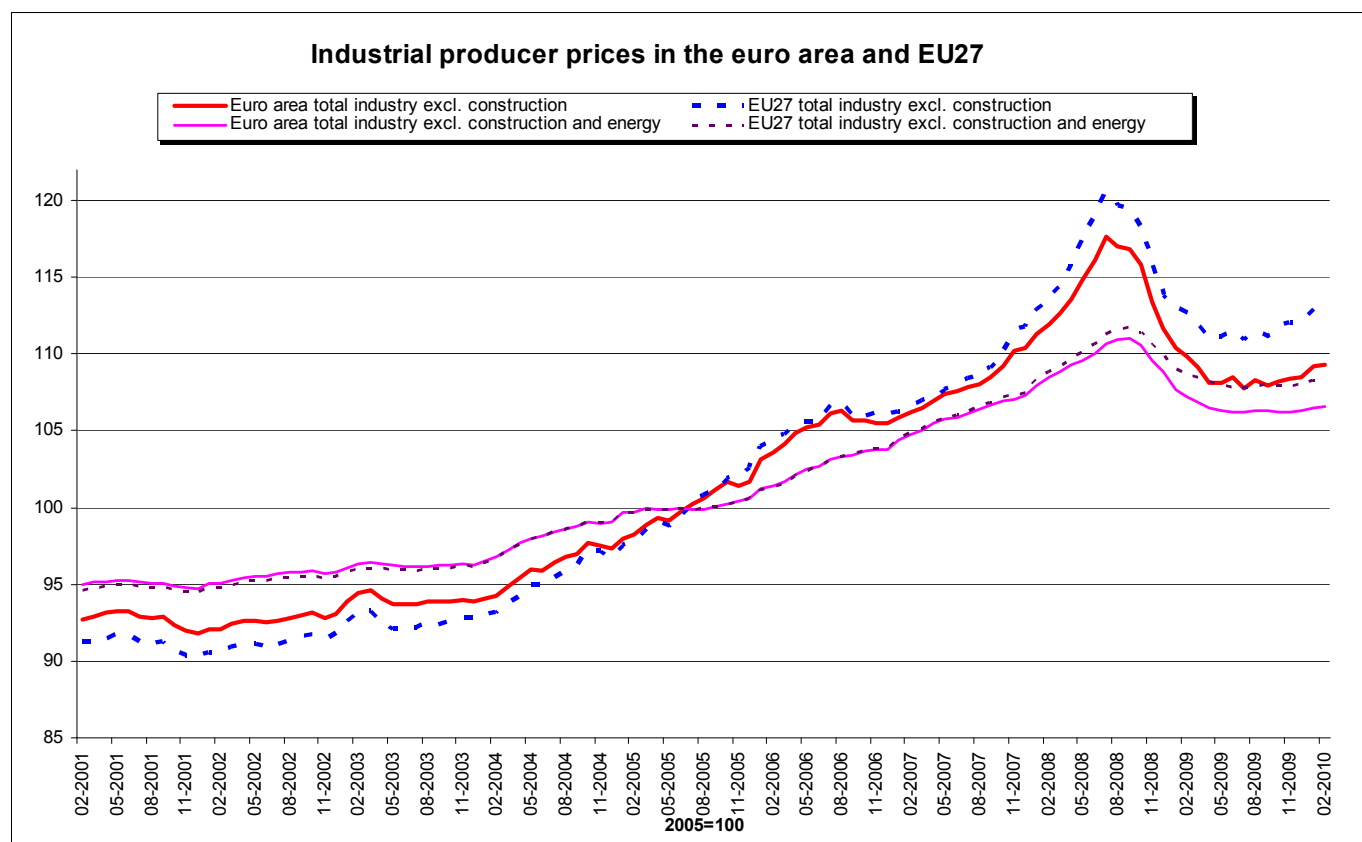
February 2010 compared with January 2010

## Industrial producer prices up by 0.1% in both euro area and EU27

In February 2010 compared with January 2010, the industrial producer price index<sup>1</sup> rose by 0.1% in both the **euro area**<sup>2</sup> (EA16) and the **EU27**<sup>2</sup>. In January<sup>3</sup>, prices increased by 0.7% and 0.8% respectively.

In February 2010 compared with February 2009, industrial producer prices fell by 0.5% in the **euro area**, but rose by 0.4% in the **EU27**.

These figures come from **Eurostat, the statistical office of the European Union**.



## Monthly changes

In February 2010, compared with the previous month, prices in total industry excluding the energy sector increased by 0.1% in both the **euro area** and the **EU27**. In both zones, prices rose by 0.3% for intermediate goods, by 0.1% for energy and for durable consumer goods, and remained stable for non-durable consumer goods. Capital goods rose by 0.1% in the **euro area** and by 0.2% in the **EU27**.

Among Member States for which data are available, the highest increases in the total index were recorded in **Lithuania** (+1.7%), **Finland** (+1.6%) and **Sweden** (+1.4%), and the largest decreases in **Slovakia** (-1.7%) and the **Czech Republic** (-0.3%).

## Annual changes

In February 2010, compared with February 2009, prices in total industry excluding the energy sector decreased by 0.6% in the **euro area** and by 0.3% in the **EU27**. Prices in the energy sector fell by 0.9% in the **euro area**, but rose by 1.7% in the **EU27**. Non-durable consumer goods dropped by 0.7% and 0.3% respectively. Capital goods declined by 0.6% in the **euro area** and by 0.3% in the **EU27**. Intermediate goods fell by 0.5% and 0.4% respectively. Durable consumer goods rose by 0.2% in the **euro area** and by 0.5% in the **EU27**.

Among Member States for which data are available, the largest decreases in the total index were observed in **Latvia** (-8.5%), **Slovakia** (-7.6%), **Germany** and **Lithuania** (both -3.1%), and the highest increases in **Denmark** (+7.2%), **Greece** (+6.1%) and **Finland** (+4.3%).

1. The index of producer prices shows (in the national currency of the country concerned) changes in the ex-works sale prices of all products sold on the domestic markets of the various countries, excluding imports. Euro area and EU indices refer to overall weighted price changes. The figures are not adjusted. Missing observations from Member States for recent months are estimated for the calculation of the euro area and the EU.  
The weights of the Member States in the EU and euro area aggregates were published in News Release 33/2009 of 12 March 2009.
2. The euro area (EA16) includes Belgium, Germany, Ireland, Greece, Spain, France, Italy, Cyprus, Luxembourg, Malta, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal, Slovenia, Slovakia and Finland.  
The EU27 includes Belgium (BE), Bulgaria (BG), the Czech Republic (CZ), Denmark (DK), Germany (DE), Estonia (EE), Ireland (IE), Greece (EL), Spain (ES), France (FR), Italy (IT), Cyprus (CY), Latvia (LV), Lithuania (LT), Luxembourg (LU), Hungary (HU), Malta (MT), the Netherlands (NL), Austria (AT), Poland (PL), Portugal (PT), Romania (RO), Slovenia (SI), Slovakia (SK), Finland (FI), Sweden (SE) and the United Kingdom (UK).
3. Data of previous months have been revised compared to those issued in the News Release 32/2010 of 2 March 2010. The monthly growth rate for January 2010 remains unchanged at +0.7% in the euro area, while it has been revised from +0.9% to +0.8% in the EU27. The annual growth rates have been revised from -1.0% to -1.1% in the euro area and from +0.1% to 0.0% in the EU27.
4. For Ireland, data in the new classification (NACE rev 2) has been estimated by Eurostat on the basis of data supplied using the old classification (NACE rev 1.1).
